



Winter Education Outside the Classroom Programme (SKI / EOTC)

The SKI and EOTC programmes start on Thursday 27th July and run for 5 Thursdays, concluding on Thursday 24th August, with 31st August as the only allocated postponement date.

The following programmes are on offer:

- 5 days at Cardrona Ski Field
- 5 days at Treble Cone Ski Field
- 5 days at the Snow Farm
- 5 days at a School Based programme - no cost *
- 4 days at a School Based programme and 1 day at Cardrona Ski Field **
- 5 days Experience programme - cost \$50 ***
- 5 days Ice Skating at Queenstown Ice Rink - cost \$125 includes transport, lessons and supervision
- 5 days Golf (for years 4/5/6) at Wanaka Golf Club - cost \$60 includes transport, lessons and supervision
- 5 days Rock Climbing - cost \$50 includes transport, lessons and supervision
- 5 days Trampoline/Skateboarding at Site Trampoline - cost \$125 includes transport, lessons and supervision
- 5 days Horse Riding - cost \$225 includes transport, theoretical and practical sessions with qualified instructors (this activity can only accommodate 12 students - first 12 applicants accepted)

* Activities may include: orienteering, indoor bowls, judo/karate, photography, enviro art, outdoor science, tramping and kiwi golf.

** Please note: students who wish to participate in the ONE day ski experience at Cardrona will spend the other 4 sessions in the School Based programme.

*** The 5 day Experience programme includes a day at each of the following: Puzzling World, Clip and Climb, Mini Golf, Bowls and a mystery activity. Students must participate in all 5 sessions.

As we have to make decisions re the staffing of each activity, there is no flexibility to amend groups, so please consider your selection carefully. Children must participate in all 5 days of the programme that is selected.

Please note: some activities require a minimum of 10 students to proceed.
